

Installing a Wall Mounted Light Panel



- Having decided where the light panel is to be fitted, hold it up to the wall and mark the 4 hole positions.
- Drill and plug the wall in an appropriate manner to offer sufficient support for the panel.
- Remove the caps from the 4 wall mounted supports and fit the body of the support to the wall using either the screw provided or another suitable for required fixing strength. The screws provided are just for general fitting, it is not suggested these are correct for all installations.
- The transformer needs to be hidden. Possible options are:
 - A. If fitting to a stud wall drill through wall behind light panel and connect transformer lead to light panel. Having Passed the lead through the wall.
 - B. Chase out the wall to allow cable to be hidden. Fill channel and paint.
 - C. Use trunking to hide cable.
- When transformer is connected to light panel, attach light panel to supports and turn on the electricity.
